

List American Anti-Fascists In Coming "War"

NEW YORK, June 23—
Nazi secrets agents in America have marked William E. Dodd, former Ambassador from the United States to Germany for death "in the event of war."

An investigation being pressed by Deutsches Volksecho, German anti-fascist newspaper here, revealed today the existence of a gigantic plot of terror and sabotage, not only against Dodd,

but against scores of prominent citizens who have criticized the Nazi regime.

A New York reader of the Erfurt Weltdienst, organ of Colonel Fleischauer, Nazi anti-Semite, queried the editors last month on what action they planned on the former ambassador's stinging criticism of Germany.

"ALL'S READY"

The paper answered on May 15:

"You ask whether we have blacklisted war-instigators like Dodd. All such persons in all lands are being listed. In the event of war, all is ready."

As evidence marshalled by the Federal Bureau of Investigation piled up today on the American Nazi spy ring, statements made by German terrorists took on new significance.

General Field Marshal Hermann Goering's personal organ, the Essener National Zeitung, recently stated that persons in "official position" in any nation who made statements to the press or in speeches against the Hitler government would be proceeded against "with German thoroughness" when the time came.
