There's no pretense of labor freedom in Hitlerland. Says the Nazi organ *Der Angriff* (May 1).

"Freedom of demonstration has been abolished. No one may choose for what or against what he will go into the streets. The right of association exists no longer. Anything which does not bear the mark of National Socialism is beyond the pale of the law. The international solidarity of labor is flatly denied. Workers' representation is abolished . . . Strikes are a thing of the past. This old weapon of class struggle has been smashed to pieces."
