Bund in Jersey Finds Anti-Red In Indian Chief

ANDOVER, N. J., July 5.—
Cherokee Chief New Moon, a descendant of America's original red
men, urged about 2,000 members of
the German-American Bund at
Camp Nordland near here yesterday
to "get those damn Communists out
of America once and for all."
Chief New Moon was the principal speaker at the camp's Fourth
of July celebration and the only one
to address the gathering in English.
Japan, the Spanish insurgents and
the Bund are fighting Communism,
he said, and the Bund's members
and the Indians are the "only true
Americans."
The Indians, he charged, are the
victims of a persecution that "very
few people know about here," with
Commissioner John Collier as "dictator."

A "Communistic city" has been set
up, he asserted, in Navajo, Ariz,
and efforts are being made to "teach
Communism" on the reservations.
