**To DriveOutCommunists To DriveOutCommunists Cross Says He'd Only Visit Yaphank to Enforce Law** Special to the Heraid Tribuns **PATCHOGUE**, L. I., July 4.—Jère-miah Cross, New York State com-mander of the American Legion, speaking today at an Americaniza-tion rally, publicly snubbed the Ger-man-American Settlement League, which had invited him to participate in yesterday's Independence Day ex-ercises at Camp Stegfried, Yaphank. The invitation had been sent to him by Ernst Muller, president of the league. "I will answer that invitation now," he said. "Mr Mullér, the only time you will see me'or my fellow-Legion-naires is when we travel to Yaphank as duly authorized deputies of law-enforcement agencies, and we will be there on business." Addressing 10,000 persons, Mr. Cross derided advocates of Nazism, Fascism and Communism. "There is nothing wrong with this country that employment could not cure in a short time," he said.
