Brooklyn, former managing editor and advertising manager of "Deut-scher Weckruf und Beobachter," German néwspaper, of 178 East Eighty-fifth Street, was sentenced yesterday in the Court of Special Sessions, Brooklyn, to a maximum penitentiary term of three years. He was convicted on June 27 of endan-gering the morals of children. According to a report read by Arthur D. Keller, probation officer, Winterscheidt exposed himself in the children's section of a Brooklyn theater on April 14. He fied and was arrested a block away, the report said. The report continued that last January he, was convicted of dis-orderly conduct, after allegedly ex-posing himself in Pennsylvania Station. Mr. Keller Also read a latter re-ceived from Effiz Kuhn, leader of the German American Bund. The letter said that Winferscheidt left the German newspicter on April 1 after three and a fifth years em-ployment. "We cannot extorvise vir-tues too highly and discreptiation while with 'us was beyond re-groach," the letter said.
