

# Nazi Meet A Fizzle; U. S. Flayed

Sing Hitler  
Songs—Assail  
G-Men, CIO

Less than 1,000 local Nazis gathered yesterday in the "woods" to hear Fuehrers Fritz Kuhn and George Froboese, blame the Jews for their being banned from Riverview Park.

Bitter attacks against the Committee for Industrial Organization featured Kuhn's ad-

dress, duplicating in this respect the harangues of the Silver-shirts, the Nazis' allies.

Another object of the Nazi attack was the U. S. Department of Justice, which Kuhn criticized at the same time that he repeated the Hitlerite slogan, "The Jew is the enemy."

There was an un-American atmosphere at the Nazi gathering in Ukrainian National Park, indicated by the uniforms aping

the Hitlerite uniforms in Germany. There was also the singing of the anti-American "Horst Wessel" song.

The Nazi swastika completely drowned out the American flag, which had to be searched for to be seen. Nazi leaders admitted to your correspondent that the turnout was disappointing.

They tried to excuse this by saying that they had to call the meeting hurriedly and secretly, in order to elude the protests of such organizations as the American Legion, the German-American League for Culture, the American League for Peace and Democracy and labor organizations.

Kuhn viciously assailed the Roosevelt government for insulting Hitler and his "Kultur" through the "persecution of the bund." Kuhn openly allied the bund here with Hitler.

Both speakers berated the press, scoffing at the idea that it should be free. "The reporters," they said, "are nothing more than the tools of the publishers, who are completely under the influence of the Russian Bolshevik Jews."
