Kuhn Routed By Veterans From Jersey

Nazi Rally in Union City Picketed By Czech Sympathizers

Fritz Kuhn, leader of the German American Nazi Bund was pelted with stones and run out of Union City, N. J., by veterans and sympathizers of Czechoslovakia today when he arrived in an automobile to address a meeting in celebration of Nazi seizure of Sudetenland.

Kuhn was rushed out of the city to save him from the angry veterans and members of various Czechoslovak and organizations who had arranged a meeting directly across from German Auditorium at 38th and Palisades Ave.

The anti-Nazi meeting, under the auspices of the Andrew Jackson Veterans Democratic Association and several Czech societies, was supported by pickets in front of the Nazi meeting. Very few turned up for Kuhn meeting. The pickets carried an effigy of Hitler and signs protesting the seizure of Czechoslovakia.

Shortly before Kuhn was driven out of town Hitler's effigy was burned.
