German Held for Threat Against Jewish Doctor

'Aryan League' Card Brings
New Orleans Arrest

NEW ORLEANS, Oct. 12 (AP) —

Joseph Hahn-Korff, thirty-five, a German, was held in jail today on a charge of sending defamatory and scurrilous matter through the mails threatening to list Dr. Alton Ochsner, of the Tulane University School of Medicine, as a Jew. United States Commissioner R. H. Carter released his bond at \$5,000.

Postoffice Inspector F. W. Peterson said a postcard, signed by Hahn-Korff as secretary of the "League for the Restoration of Aryan Supremacy in America," sent to Dr. Ochsner, read:

"An effort is being made for the benefit of unsuspecting gentiles to list all racial Jews in this territory.

"Your name as well as your character suggests, according to testimony by a number of former associates of yours, that you are either 100 per cent or partly Jewish.

"Should you fail to produce convincing evidence to the contrary within a reasonable period of time you will be listed as described above. N. B.—We are not interested in your religious denomination."

Peterson said Hahn-Korff entered this country about ten years ago but was never naturalized.
