BUND MEETING RAIDED

Police Clear Hall and Stop

Chicago Street Fights.

CHICAGO, Oct. 22 (A. Serent)

eral police squads broke up a freefor-all fight last aight between German-American Bund members and
a crowd of anti-Nazi demonstrators.

The demonstrators stormed a
meeting hall in the heart of the
German district. The police cleared
the hall, but fights continued in the
street until reserve officers arrived.

The meeting had been called by
Dr. Homer Maerz, president of the
newly formed German-American alliance. He had promised to explain
what happened last Sunday at another meeting broken up by antiNazis.

The police estimated the crowd in
the hall at 300 and the demonstrators outside at 1,000.
