FRITZ KUHN ARRESTED

**Bund Leader Called Disorderly
After Traffic Violation**

EDGEWATER, N. J., Oct. 27.—
Fritz Kuhn, head of the German-American Bund, must appear before Recorder William P. Leary here on Nov. 7 to answer charges of passing a red light and disorderly conduct. Mr. Kuhn, who gave his address as 178 East Eighty-fifth Street, Manhattan, was arrested yesterday afternoon by Patrolman Francis Kennedy after he allegedly drove past the stop signal on his way to the Edgewater Ferry. According to Patrolman Kennedy, Mr. Kuhn protested that he was in a hurry and an argument started, with the result that the policeman wrote out a disorderly conduct summons in addition to the one for the traffic violation. Mr. Kuhn was released in \$25 bail pending the hearing.
