MERCHANTS IN
MONTANA BOYCOTT
ALL NAZI GOODS

BILLINGS, Mont., Nov. 29.—Montana merchants urged nation-wide extension today of a boycott of German-produced goods.

A statement by the Independent Merchants Association of Montana asked co-operation of "the people of the United States." The majority of state merchants are association members.

"During complete isolation of Germany, the statement said, in June, the German barbarism should not be tolerated any longer by civilization. The merchants of Montana share it, by definition, that any nation that indulges in such barbarous procedure should be socially, economically, and commercially ostracized. Therefore, we shall refrain from purchasing merchandise of any kind manufactured in and under the German regime and kindly ask the people of the United States to join with us in a general boycott of all merchandise produced in Germany and its affiliated territories."
