'Quarantine Nazis' Say L. A. Germans

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 11. — The German-American League for Culture of Los Angeles, an anti-Nazi organization of German-born members, has sent a telegram to President Franklin Roosevelt, joining in his plea for a quarantine of the Nazi aggressors because of recent barbaric attitudes.

The League for Culture, a nation-wide organization, through Frank Steinway, secretary, asked that President Roosevelt continue his protests against the actions of the Hitlerites.

The telegram to the President read:

The membership meeting of the German-American Culture League, Los Angeles local, joins with you in protest against inhumane and barbaric attitude of present German government against racial and religious minorities.

Such medieval and terrorist actions have no room in a civilized society. We Americans of German extraction deplore deeply the fact that such repulsive behavior will tend to besmear the good name of that Germany which has contributed so much to the development of humanitarian ideals.

In order to protect this well-earned traditional achievement of all civilized Germans, we join with all those who believe in the American ideals in requesting vigorous action against the Nazi madmen and their paid agents in the United States.
