Mayor Studies Plan to Exclude Nazi Shipping

Commissioner of Docks John Mc-Kenzie conferred yesterday with Mayor LaGuardia at City Hall on a. proposal to bar Nazi steamship lines from renewing leases on city-owned piers.

The proposal, first put forward by City Council President Newbold Morris, has received the full support of the Dock Commissioner.

Mr. McKenzie said he favored ending the North German Lloyd and Hapag steamship docking permits in New York Harbor as an American protest against persecution of Jews, Catholisc and Protestants by the Hitler regime.

Mayor LaGuardia, it was reliably learned, will take entire matter of German shipping up with the State Department in Washington.
