

# Ban on All Nazis Here

## Proposed

Former Reichstag  
Member Warns  
U.S. to Beware

WASHINGTON, Dec. 20—  
Outlawing of all Nazi activities  
in the United States was urged  
here last night by Gerhart Se-  
ger, former member of the Ger-  
man Reichstag.

Speaking at the Wash-  
ington Town Hall Forum,  
Seger, who is now editor  
of the Neue Volkzeitung in  
New York, urged immedi-  
ate dissolution of all Nazi  
camps in this country and  
suppression of all semi-mili-  
tary organizations in the  
U. S.

"The United States should by  
all means avoid repeating the  
mistakes made by the young  
German republic before Hitler  
came to power," he said.

Other governmental steps  
urged by Seger are:

1. A close check on the  
activities of diplomatic rep-  
resentatives of fascist gov-  
ernments.
2. Probing of the "Ger-  
man-American Business  
League," which Seger ac-  
cused of using money ob-  
tained from German-Amer-  
ican business men to finance  
Nazi propaganda in this  
country.
3. Halting of all ex-  
change of professors and  
students with the Nazis.
4. Passage of an act provid-  
ing for government clearance of  
all inheritance cases between the  
United States and Germany.
