BUND CHIEF SCORES JEW

Kuhn, at Jersey Meeting, Chide Legion Man for Opposition

NEW MILFORD, N. J., Feb. 7.—

If the United States is to avoid communism, the Jews in this country must be driven from their high posts in government, finance and education, as they have been in certain European countries, Fritz Kuhn of New York, national leader of the German-American Bund, declared here tonight.

Mr. Kuhn spoke at a meeting of the Bergen County unit of the bund at the home of Miss Caroline Meade, teacher and Shakespearean actress. He chided C. I. Johnston, commander of the post of the American Legion here, for opposing the bund, declaring it and the Legion had a common foe in communism. He denied the bund was un-American.

About 200 persons attended the meeting, thirty-five of them in the blue and gray uniforms of the organization. Mr. Johnston, who had been invited, did not attend, but seven other Legion members did. Mayor George Mack also was present.
