Observers to Report Nazi Bund Meeting

NEW MILFORD, N. J., Feb. 8.—Official "observers" sent by the American Legion to a private house meeting in New Milford last night of the Nazi German-American Bund prepared a report today for Commander C. I. Johnston on the Bund's reply to a denunciation of its activity by the local American Legion post as "unwelcome and un-American."

Two hundred persons heard Fritz Kuhn, the Bund's national director, answer the charges by attacking in turn the Jews, the Committee for Industrial Organization and Communism.

"Our purpose is to save the United States," Kuhn proclaimed, and then belabored the CIO as "a Communist organization" of which John L. Lewis "is just the figurehead."

The Jews, Kuhn said, "are trying to get you right by the neck and at the same time are trying to confuse the issue by attacking the German-American Bund."
