Bund Alliance Seen After Klan's Nordland Rally

Andover, N. J., Aug. 19. (AP).—An out-in-the-open flareup among elements of the German-American Bund and welding of a sympathy relationship between the bund and the Ku Klux Klan appeared today to be the fruits of a Klan "Americanization" rally at the bund's Camp Nordland here.

The rally was disrupted yesterday when six men began distributing a pamphlet entitled "An Appeal to Friends of Fritz Kuhn." Kuhn, former national leader of the bund, is serving a prison term for misuse of organization funds.

The six were arrested and later fined \$10 each on disorderly conduct charges. Two of the six then pressed assault and battery charges against August Klapprott, camp manager, and two other bund leaders.

The pamphlet incident came midway in the rally for which the New Jersey Klan had rented the camp from the bund. Earlier, Klapprott extended a welcome to "the antiwar, pro-Americans who had the courage to attend this rally."
