## Christians Gets 5 Years for Sedition

CHATTANOOGA, Tenn., June 8 (UP).-George W. Christians, leader of the "Crusader White Shirts" was sentenced by Federal Judge Leslie Darr to five years imprisonment today, following his conviction last week of sedition. Christians was returned to jail without bond after the

sentencing.

The defendant had been charged with sending to members of the armed forces letters and other liter-ature which the government chargarmed forces letters and other liter-ature which the government charg-ed tended to incite insubordination. Some of the letters urged action by force to put into effect what Chris-tians has called his "human effort monetary" economic system. Christians was convicted on four counts of sedition.
