Fascist Youth Group Organized In Pennsylvania

YORK, Pa., June 16.—The youth of this city, young men between the ages of 16 and 20, are being asked to join an outright fascist strike-breaking organization to be known as the "Da-Johns."

C. L. MacKenzie, a local counterpart of a Black Legionnaire, is heading the organization drive. According to him, the youth will be organized along military lines, though it will be "non-military" in action.

Parents must release the organization from responsibility for "damages that might result from injury or loss of life, should such occur while in the performance of duty." The release which the parents are being asked to sign requires that they "realize that, in the cause of humanity, there must necessarily be some risks attached to the performance of emergency duty."

Fathers of the boys are also asked to join the organization as a "Da-John Father," and to oppose "any system or government which directly or indirectly prohibits the worship of God." The parents are also asked to join the organization and to fight against "atheistic" teachers and "influences" in the schools.
