

Grand Jury Questions Two Fish Secretaries

Walter J. Reynolds, secretary to Representative Fish, Republican, of New York, and George Hill, Mr. Fish's second secretary, were questioned this afternoon by the additional District grand jury inquiring into alleged Nazi propaganda.

Along with Charles Wilson, an employe of the House, they were questioned shortly after a number of mail sacks, reputedly full of franked matter of members of Congress who are sympathetic with the isolationists' viewpoint, were delivered to the jury.

The sacks were brought to the jury after being removed from outside a storeroom assigned to Mr. Fish at the House Office Building.
