

Propaganda by Lawrence Dennis, ideological exponent of native Fascism, appeared in some 400 American papers last week, including at least one Army camp paper, the Westover Flyer, of the Westover, Mass. air base. The mats and proofs for the weekly debate feature, entitled Wake Up, America, are distributed free of charge by the American Economic Foundation. The Foundation says it tries to get diametrically opposed viewpoints and accepts the debaters' self-identifications. But how many of the editors and readers of the 400 papers using this debate knew that Lawrence Dennis, "celebrated author and former member of the U. S. Diplomatic Corps," was denied a commission by the Army last spring, after PM disclosed that he was the brain truster for many American Fascists?
