10 TAMPANS ARE CALLED TO TELL OF COMMUNISM

Legislators Will Inquire Into 'Isms

TALLAHASSEE, June 1.—(By Staff Correspondent.)—Ten Tampans were included today on a list of witnesses to be summoned before a joint house and senate committee appointed to investigate reported un-American influences in Florida.

The committee announced it would begin hearings shortly after the end of the legislature this week to inquire into communism, bolshevism, pacifism and other theories of government subversive to our democratic theory of government.

Who They Are

Listed by the group as witnesses from Tampa are Rosita Marina, Jose Martinez, Pedro Moya, Emillion Cruz, Lima El Macho, Lorenzo Puentes, Marie Perez, Albert Simmons, Charles Lindian and Antonio Lindian.

"These are only a few that the committee intends to summon," Representative Cooley, of Lake county, chairman, said. "We already have considerable data on reported communistic activities at Tampa, Jacksonville and other Florida cities from patriotic organizations, such as the American legion, the Reserve Officers association, and other veterans' groups.

At Work Ten Years

"The committee intends to go fully into these things and try to stamp out once and for all a subversive element that has been working in the state for the last 10 years."

Cooley added the committee would devote much of its time to reports of un-Americanism in Florida schools and colleges. Named to serve with Cooley are Representatives Kelly, of Nassau, and Cray of Martin; Senators Holland, of Bartow, Tillman of Tampa, and Kanner of Stuart.
