# Rogue's Gallery Backs Fascist Publication

LOS ANGELES.—A real rogue's gallery could be made of the backers of the so-called "Constitutional Defender," official organ of the "Constitution Society of America," carrying on anti-labor and pro-Fascist propaganda here.

The gallery would include Harry Chandler, anti-labor publisher of the L.A. Times; Dr. Ray Lyman Wilbur, Stanford University president; Dr. Ernest C. Moore, ex-head of the University of California at Los Angeles; ex-President Herbert Hoover, Federal Judge Benjamin F. Bledsoe; Archbishop John J. Cantwell; Mayor Frank L. Shaw; Chief Deputy City Attorney Walter A. Dodd of San Francisco; Municipal Judge Oda Faulconer; Gertrude Rounsavelle, chairman of the L.A. Board of Education.

These are the rogues supporting this Fascist paper and its policies.

The "Constitutional Defender" urges that Earl Browder, Communist presidential candidate, be deported and claims the sole aim of the Communist Party is a "ghastly world war."

The paper is published by Robert Dyer Hobday, for "capitalism and the profit system."
