Mr. FISH introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

JOINT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the President of the United States to purchase or otherwise acquire by peaceful means islands or possessions of non-American nations within the Western Hemisphere.

1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 That the President of the United States is hereby authorized 4 to acquire, by peaceful means or by purchase, islands and 5 possessions of non-American nations within the Western 6 Hemisphere.

7 SEC. 2. That there is hereby authorized to be appro-8 priated, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise 9 appropriated, such sum or sums as may be necessary upon 10 recommendation of the President to carry out the purpose 11 of this joint resolution.
