

Nazi Quarters Near KGFJ Stormed

Describes Thrilling
Scenes as "Deutches
Haus" is Picketed

Sensational back-
ground for the voice of
the EAGLE commentator

last night was the muffled, throbbing cry of "Down with . . . Hitler," from pickets of the "Deutches Haus," reported Nazi headquarters a few doors away from radio station of KGFJ.

The Negro Newspaper of the air, heard nightly over the station, went out over the ether waves last night mingled with the anti-Nazi choruses of communist and other pickets, who stormed the famed German headquarters on Fifteenth street, near Figueroa. Aided by a great amplifying system, the anti-Aryan outcries penetrated KGFJ's nearby, though vaulted studios.

In a strange twist of fate the radio station, which is Southern California's leading news dispensary, became a headline source itself.

The EAGLE radio-reporter, in the program's first "spot" broadcast, described at first hand, without script, the antics of the throng of several hundreds that hurled glowing defiance at Herr Adolph Hitler's stories below. During
