Kuhn Stumped By National Anthem Verse

NEWARK, Jan. 4. — Fritz Kuhn, head of the Nazi German-American Bund, came up against the "Star Spangled Banner" yesterday at a liquor license appeal hearing here and was "stumped."

Asked to recite the first verse of the national anthem the loud-mouthed Nazi was dumb. "I

don't see any reason to do it," Kuhn said. He was saved from further embarrassment when the request was dropped.

Kuhn was giving testimony at the hearing of an appeal by Billy George Backofen, Union City tavern owner, from the decision of the Union City Board of Commissioners suspending his license. This was a result of a meeting from which Kuhn left under a heavy police guard after hundreds demonstrated protesting the appearance of the Nazi leader
