For the Record: Nazis Blast II, Praise IO

Let it be placed upon the record that ten men were mentioned with approval by Fritz Kuhn and other officials of the Nazi German American Bund in their speeches Monday night at Madison Square Garden; that each of these won applause from the fascists there assembled; that the names upon this roll of dishonor are:

Father Coughlin, Hitler, Herbert Hoover, Senators Gerald P. Nye, Hiram Johnson and General Hugh Johnson, Major-General Van Horn Moseley, Rev. Edward Lodge Curran, Congressman Martin Dies, Mussolini.

Let it also be remembered that the eleven individuals singled out for attack by the agents of Hitler were:

President Franklin D. Roosevelt and four members of the cabinet, Attorney General Frank Murphy, Secretary of Labor Frances Perkins, Secretary of Commerce Harry Hopkins, and Secretary of Interior Harold Ickes, Supreme Court Justice Felix Frankfurter, columnist Walter Winchell, attorney Samuel Untermyer and Bernard Baruch, former head of the War Industries Board; Congressman Samuel Dickstein and former Congressman Thomas Amlie.
