Use of Officers' Names
Bennet Gets Show-Cause
Order Against Kukn
Fritz Kuhn, hational head of the
pro-Nazi German-American Bund,
has been named in an action to
show cause why publication of the
"Deutscher Weckruf und Beobachter," described as the official organ
of the bund, should not be stopped
unless names of the officers of the
publishing corporation are printed
in each issue, it was announced yesterday at the office of Attorney
General John J. Bennett jr.

The order was signed Monday by
Justice Bernard L. Shientag, in Supreme Court, and is returnable tomorrow before Justice Aron Steuer.
It names the A. V. Publishing Corporation, of 178 East Eighty-fifth
Street, as publisher of the paper,
and Kuhn, "John Doe" and "Jane
Doe" as officers of the corporation.

Today's issue of the paper, which
also carries the title, "The Free
American," states on the editorial
page, "Published by A. V. Publishing
Corporation, Inc." Beneath that is
the statement, in German, "Responsible for the entire contents:
Fritz Kuhn."

The action is based on Section 300
of the General Business Law which
requires that newspapers in each in

The action is based on Section 300 of the General Business Law which requires that newspapers in each issue carry the name and address of the corporation owning or publishing the publication, together with full names and addresses of the president, secretary and treasurer. Benjamin Heffner, Assistant Attorney General, said it was not the intention of the Attorney General to force the paper to cease publication, but merely to require observance of the law.
