NAZI BUND HEAD IN LEGAL TANGLE IN NEW YORK

NEW YORK, March 18 (UP)

Legal difficulties piled up today for Fritz Kuhn, leader of the German-American Bund.

Commissioner of Investigation William B. Herlands, it became known, has subpoenaed Kuhn in an inquiry to determine whether proper taxes have been paid in the sale of Bund books and literature.

Kuhn also was served today with a subpoena in a criminal libel action filed by former Magistrate Joseph Goldstein, who alleges he was libelled by the Bund organ, the "Deutscher Weckruf und Beobachter."

Kuhn likewise must appear in court tomorrow to show cause why publication of the newspaper shall not be stopped unless officials of the paper are printed in each issue. The attorney general's office is pressing this point.
