Libel Hearing

BROOKLYN, N. Y., March 3
(TP).—Fritz Kuhn, fuehrer of the German-American Bund, was paroled in the custody of his attorney today for a hearing March 10 on charges of criminal libel.

Kuhn appeared before Magistrate Brill in an answer to a summons obtained, by former Magistrate Goldstein. The leader of the Bund was charged with referring to Goldstein in his organization's newspaper "as a legal shark."

More than 40 uniformed policemen and detectives guarded the courtroom during the hearing. There was no disturbance.
