

Nazi Bund Charged With False Advertising

NEW YORK.—"False and fraudulent advertising" in representing their Madison Square Garden rally as a patriotic celebration of George Washington's birthday is the charge that has been filed against the German-American Bund by the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League.

The complaint sworn out declares that the Bund "for the purpose of realizing a huge profit from the sale of tickets and from donations," advertised as it did.

"The meeting was held and sponsored, in fact, for the thinly-disguised purpose of fostering and attaining objectives directly contrary of the well-known, and historically authenticated ideals of George Washington.

"Far from having any connection with the patriotism and ideals of George Washington, the Bund and its meeting represent a crass and commercialized desecration of his memory," the complaint states.

It referred to the Bund as "alias the Friends of New Germany, alias German American Business League, alias German American Fund," and charged that approximately \$25,000 was collected for admissions and donations.
