Fuehrer Sentenced In Pittsburgh

PITTSBURGH, March 17.—Eugene Harsch, Pittsburgh Fuehrer of the German-American Bund, today was sentenced to jail for six months and fined \$500 on charges of practicing medicine without a license.

Harsch, a naturopath, first was convicted of practicing medicine without a license in 1935 and placed on parole. The sentence Judge Egan imposed was the most lenient that could be given for a second offense.
