# Florida Police Hold 2 Nazis After Fight

## 'White Front' Leaders Arrested in Brawl in Barroom

CORAL GABLES, Fla., March 17 (UP).—Two men wearing uniforms resembling those of Nazi storm troopers were held by police after a barroom dispute over their "white front" organization.

Raymond Healey, 26, who last fall served a jail sentence for disorderly conduct in connection with a pro-Nazi meeting in a Miami barroom, and William Blanchard, Jr., who said he was national leader of a "White Front" movement, were booked on open charges.

Police also held H. E. Hill, 30, and John P. Holbrook, 34, who were involved in the altercation but denied any affiliation with Healey and Blanchard. Three other persons later were released.

Blanchard told police the "White Front" movement had "a 24-point program, one of which stresses the fact Jews are one of the nation's principal problems."
