Kuhn Threatens 'Statements'
Soon on Finding Hearing Put Off

Fritz Kuhn, German-American Bund leader, became angry yesterday morning when he reported for a continued session of the city's sales tax inquiry into his organization and found that the hearing had been postponed because of the illness of City Treasurer Almerindo Portfolio.

"I'll begin to make statements pretty soon," the Bund leader threatened.

Vahan H. Kalenderian, his attorney, stepped in quickly and said, "No statements," reminding his client that Mr. Portfolio's illness was reasonable cause for the adjournment.

"Pretty soon I will make statements, but not now," Kuhn said.

Abraham Bloch, aide to Commissioner of Investigation William B. Herlands, said Mr. Herlands would make an appropriate answer to anything Kuhn might say publicly.
