Greet His Hollywood Appearance

Fuehrer Tells Mob
Texan Means 'The
Same Things We Do'

LOS ANGELES, May 23 —
Representative Martin Dies
spoke here last night with the
full blessings of the Nazi Ger-
man-American Bund, The Peo-
ple's World learned today.

Dies spoke at the Hollywood
Bowl to a so-called "Stand By
America" rally.

On the day prior to his appear-
ance, at a Nazi rally in Hindenburg
Park, Herman Schwinn, West Coast
Nazi fuehrer, extended his felicita-
tions to the Texas Congressman
who gained nation-wide notoriety
for his conduct of the House un-
Americanism investigation.

Schwinn told assembled Nazis:
"We wish to give our recommen-
dation to Dies, the Hearst Exam-
iner and the American Legion for
bringing this real American to
Los Angeles. We know that when
they say Stand By America, they
mean the same thing we do."

The Dies Committee is ostensibly
investigating Nazi activities, but
Schwinn's words were well received
by the assembly.

The Nazi rally attracted some
2,000 persons who came to hear
Fritz Kuhn, national fuehrer of the
Bund.

Dies attacked liberalism here and
advocates of "statism."

He called "statism" the "most
liberal and reactionary doctrine the
world has ever seen."

He said he was a staunch advo-
cate of Americanism and the con-
stitution.

Before his meeting, he announced
that his committee would hold
hearings on the Pacific Coast this
summer.
