## 500 of Bund Hear Kuhn

Speaking at Camp Nordland, He Says  
Unit Will Open in Rockland

ANDOVER, N. J., June 15.—Fritz Kuhn, leader of the German-American Bund, now awaiting trial in New York City on an indictment charging grand larceny, spoke here today before more than 500 members of the Bund at Camp Nordland. Speaking in German, he said that twenty-one Bund camps were operating throughout the country and that a new unit would open soon in Rockland County, N. Y.

Kuhn insisted on his innocence of the charge of appropriating funds from the Bund to his own use.

William Kunze, director of public relations for the Bund, another speaker, assailed legislation which would make it illegal for organizations such as the Bund to meet in uniform. He described the proposed measure as "discriminating against the Bund."
