To Continue Bund Probe In Baltimore School

BALTIMORE, June 18 (UP).—A special committee of Baltimore school officials prepared today to continue an investigation of the "branding" of a 14-year-old Jewish high school student by a group of classmates.

The boys allegedly scratched the initial "H" on the neck of Melvin Bridge and inked a swastika on his forehead in an episode which brought charges that a juvenile Nazi bund existed at Gwynn's Falls junior high school which Melvin attended.

The special committee, scheduled

to meet early next week, was appointed by Dr. David E. Weglein, Superintendent of Schools, at the request of the Baltimore school board to find out definitely whether a bund organization exists in the school. The committee is made up of Dr. Norman B. Cole, John D. Steele and Mrs. Mercedes Ford.

The committee was named shortly after a Grand Jury dismissed assault charges made against Morton Rosen, 19, a friend of the Bridge boy who accompanied him to school after the branding incident as a sort of bodyguard.
