Nazi Propaganda Exhibited Here

Bureau Also Lists Hitler's Backers

The country's largest exhibit of Nazi-inspired propaganda, literature to incite race hatred and subversive writings has been assembled by the Bureau of Propaganda Investigation of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League to Champion Human Rights, 20 W. 47th St.

Forty posters revealing methods of anti-Semitic attack have been placed on display at the bureau headquarters and the vast files have been made available to accredited organizations. There is also a display of German-made goods, showing devices used to conceal where it was manufactured.

This exhibit includes paint brushes with "Made in America" plainly stamped on the wooden handle and "Germany" printed in small type in a sunken groove of the ferrule which holds the hair. There is a collection of German books for children which are strongly anti-Semitic.

The bureau has background information on every person who has been even remotely connected with propaganda work in America, officials say.
