EXPOSE NOTED BUNDSMAN

Coughlinite Found to Be Veteran Hitlerite

A leading spokesman for the Coughlinite "Christian Mobilizers" whose writings openly call for pogroms against American Jewry this week was revealed as an active Nazi so important in the German-American Bund that he was sent as delegate to several meetings in the Third Reich.

The spokesman, who uses the name Ernest F. Elmhurst, because his own name, Fleischkopf "is too Jewish," has been a member of the Nazi bund in New York since its inception.

In August, 1937, American Nazis sent him to attend the international conference at Erfurt, Germany, where Hitler's World Service propaganda agency planned its program of work.

At that session, delegates drafted and mailed a letter to Robert E. Edmondson of New York City, praising his anti-democratic and anti-Semitic work.

Delegates of 22 nations signed the letter, including "C. G. Campbell, U.S.A., Ernest F. Elmhurst, U.S.A." Campbell's identity has not yet been established.

Elmhurst is one of the most vigorous Jew-baiters operating in the United States today. In the Christian Mobilizers, he is associated with Joe McWilliams, lieutenant of Father Coughlin.

In an article on the subject, "Our National Issue," in the Oct. 14 issue of "The Christian Mobilizer," the organization's publication, he says: "Jewry, yield; else pogroms."

The propagandist works closely with the Silver Shirts. He made his first contact with William Dudley Pelley two years ago and early last year wrote a book, "The World Hoax," in collaboration with him.
