Reich Writer Sentenced to

BERLIN, Jan. 10.—The German writer, Ernst Niekisch was sentenced to life imprisofment today after having been found guilty of carrying on illegal underground activities.

Besides serving the prison term Niekisch will lost his civil rights permanently. Included in the charges against him was the distribution of anti-Nazi literature.

In British newspapers Niekisch is named as former confidential agent of the late Colonel General Hans

of the late Colonel General Hans

Niekisch is a former teacher who became an author and publisher. He appears to have been a follower of the Ernst Roehm group among the Natis which called for reforms in the "Third Reich."

In a book of Niekisch's he called Hitler Germany's misfortune. He was arrested last March.
