

Nazis 'Recruit' Here

WASHINGTON, April 13—(UP)—The Dies Committee will investigate reports that members of the German-American Bund are recruiting Americans for Nazi factories, it was disclosed today, by Rep. John J. Dempsey, D., N. M., a member of the committee.

He said agents would begin an immediate investigation of the reported practice. Rep. Dempsey declared he had "extensive information" that Bund representatives were offering skilled workers jobs in German munitions plants.

He said the agents made "flattering and glowing" offers to unemployed craftsmen, assuring them passage to Germany, a home and a

"living wage" in return for their services for two years under a contract.

Dempsey said the reports were reliable, but that he wanted a full investigation "to show the people of the United States what is going on."

He said the recruiting campaign was inaugurated by the German government to meet an acute skilled labor shortage.
