Gyonel MILWAUKEE, June 14 and Kelzer, assistant United States Di-trict Attorney, said today that Hue R. Opitz, seventy-one years old, had been indicted on a charge of illegaly wearing a United States Army uni-form at a rally May 27 at the Mil-waukee auditorium of the German-American Volksbund. Opitz, who appeared at the meet-ing in Army uniform and carrying a pistol in a holster, was billed on the bund program as "Col. Benjamin J. Blackey, retired surgeon general of the United States Army." Opitz is held in Chicago, where he was taken into custody shortly after his Milwaukee appearance on a commissioner's warrant obtained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. A removal hearing will be held in Chicago June 20. Milwaukee police hold two warrants issued twenty-three years ago charging Opitz with abandoning his family and defraud-ing a hotel keeper.
