

BUND SYMPATHIZER SAILS

Jersey Woman and Daughters Go
to Reich for 'Indefinite' Stay

NEW MILFORD, N. J., May 29. Mrs. Adam Kunze of 255 Boulevard here, sailed with her three daughters on the Bremen for Germany at midnight, Friday, it was learned here today. Mrs. Kunze, whose stage name is Caroline Meade, has been leader in German-American bund activities in Bergen County and has been hostess to Fritz Kuhn and his aides. A member of the family said she would remain in Germany "indefinitely."

Prior to last October, when a bund meeting open to the public ended in disorder at her home, Mrs. Kunze frequently held sessions of the county organization in her dwelling. At the open meeting members of patriotic and veterans' organizations attended and fist fights occurred between bund members and their non-admirers.
