<u>Hanfstaengl</u> Held In Canadian Camp,

Letter Tells Son

Cambridge, Mass., Sept. 22 (AP).—
A letter with a Canadian postmark made the opening of his sophomore year at Harvard a happy one yesterday for Egon Hanfstaengl.

The letter was from his father, Ernst ("Putzi") Hanfstaengl, Harvard graduate, former Nazi foreign press chief and friend of Hitler, who was interned in England, where he was living when the European war broke out.

The elder Hanfstaengl, who left Germany several years ago for what he called "voluntary exile," told his son he was in a Canadian prison camp. How he got there, when or where the camp is located, the letter did not disclose.
