¶ This Neutrality issue is a big laugh. They will ship stuff whether there is a law or not anyhow. The stuff they ship will be thrown together so hurriedly it won't do them any good. Even Alsop and Kinter admit that Germany has at least three years backlog of resources to go on, and that checks with information, including Albert Whiting Fox, Washington lawyer, who was in Germany and saw Hitler late in the summer -- and his letter of Sept. 22d, a long one, published Sunday in Sept. 24th issue of the NY Times, editorial page. I'm writing it up as fast as I can, but it is long letter and I'm running it into what would be a two-page printed article or more. He explodes a lot of silly propaganda. Be sure to get for the Doctor Nye's "Propaganda in the Next War" speech, Apr. 25, 1939, in the Record, and Nye has reprints -- several hundred thousand distributed already. I am hoping to see in booklet form and prepared it and shot it through.
