To-day has been one busy one---Spent the greater part of day on Hill with Doctor's

to you---His ( The Doctor's) suggestion is to the effect that requests to him  
for reprints of his speech or other matter, be given me---His secretaries preparing

to be transmitted to you for price & etc---The Doctor suggests that neither he  
or his office (Miss Anderson ) appear in print at any time, during such transaction--  
And after talking the thing over with all concerned, and in order that such mailing  
and etc. might be expedited it was suggested as in above, and I will fill out the  
applications as ~~xxx~~ enclosed and mail to you for appropriate action---How does  
this strike you ???? Several letters already received by the Doctor calling for  
various numbers, one letter requesting price on one thousand---

minutes or record obtained by Dies Committee, a Major Wilson, is one of them---This  
is off record of course, to be placed on the ICB for future reference....
