"A"---Received your letters directed to Hatfield, and to Mr. Beacham this Am.. Have not heard from them at any time, but was advised by Dr. Thorselson that they called upon him last night at his apartment and had quite a chat---Have quite naturally expected to see the Chief, but haven't so far had the opportunity to hand him the communications for himself or Hatfield ---Would have expected them to have picked up message on way past my place ---However I will hold same until requested to return it to you in Biltmore....

"B"---As it is I have a very important message to transmit to THE CHIEF, it concern the operations of certain attorneys here, and I have been threatened with bodily harm if I DON'T GO ALONG WITH THE BOYS in a certain case which is coming up in District Court---I REALLY mean that I have been personally threatened with bodily harm---If it comes it will come from Herbert Glasman quarters, but no doubt there will be NO PROOF showing that he was or is implicated---Now get this straight---THIS IS NOT FOR PUBLICATION---It is off record---However true it may appear or untrue, someone has suddenly decided that I should become a factor in the Dies--Gardner--Lebowitz play---I can not write the details---Put this on ICE, because I want a RECORD of THIS NOTE where it may be found IN CASE of an unpleasant situation occurring---In which case I am forced to believe that I will come out O.K.---Am advising the Doctor to-morrow, and taking his advise as to protective methods---
