

Wheeler Appoints Defense Spy Probers

Senator Burton K. Wheeler (D.) of Montana, chairman of the Senate Interstate Commerce Committee, yesterday appointed seven members to a subcommittee charged with investigating foreign influence in American defense industries. Wheeler named himself as chairman and Senators Harry S. Truman (D.) of Missouri, Edwin C. Johnson (D.) of Colorado, Homer T. Bone (D.) of Washington, Warren R. Austin (R.) of Vermont, Wallace White (R.) of Maine, and Clyde M. Reed (R.) of Kansas.
