PHILADELPHIA. June 16.—Parisnioners of Old Zion's Lutheran Church put up \$25,000 cash ball yesterday for the release of their pastor, the Rev. Kurt E. B. Molzahn, indicted by a Federal grand jury in Hartford, Conn., on charges of espionage for the Axis.

The money, some in dollar bills, was turned over to United States Commissioner Norman J. Griffin by Dr. Karl F. Haussmann, 70-year-old former German and Latm instructor at the Germantown High School. Mr. Molzahn was one of his pupils.

The clergyman will be given a hearing tomorrow before the United States Commissioner on the question of extraditing him to Hartford. Te has protested his innocence.
