"Our strategy is to destroy the enemy from within, to conquer him through himself."

In these words spoken by Hitler, recorded by Hermann Rauschning in The Voice of Destruction, Hitler sums up the strategy his League of Benedict Arnolds are pushing in their treasonable undeclared war against the United States. He also said:

"I shall shrink from nothing. No so-called international law, no agreements will prevent me from making use of any advantage that offers. .

"It is a good idea to have at least two German societies in every country. One of them can always call attention to its loyalty to the country in question, and will have the function of fostering social and economic

Repudiation Technique

"The other one may be radical and revolutionary. It will have to be prepared to be frequently repudiated by myself and other German authorities.

Valuable Racial Elements

Hitler said, in Mein Kampf:

The German Reich as a state must embrace all Germans not only for the purpose of uniting and maintaining the most valuable racial elements of this nation, but also for the purpose of raising the German nation gradually and safely to a dominating position.

Hitler instructed his lieutenants to see that these members of the German nation—including the 8,000,000 in the United States and the 500,000 in Canada, and the 6,500,000 in Latin America-obeyed orders. They did.

The laws of Germany were extended to provide expropriation, imprisonment, torture or beheading for Germans abroad, or their relatives, who did not carry out Hitler's in-

structions. There is no appeal.

Hitler then set up the Auslandsorganiza tion or Foreign Organization of the Nazi party. Its Gauleiter is Ernest Wilhelm Bohle.

Disciplined Benedict Arnold Legions were created in strategic places. The number of actual foreign units under Bohle, actual subdivisions of the Nazi government, are considerable. Three years ago Dr. Heinz Toetter boasted that the Nazi party was established firmly in 60 countries.

Every agency of the Nazi government was used to tighten this international organization: the army, the navy, the diplomatic and consular agencies, traveling educators, scientists, teachers, commercial travelers

When German Americans had been marshalled by threat or by propaganda into Nazi secret societies, their program was stated to them broadly in an official publication from Stuttgart:

We want to bring the Germans in the United States, who in part have become alienated from the German fatherland and from the German nation back to the great community of blood and fate of all Germans. To this end, the spiritual regeneration of the Germans, after the model of the homeland, is necessary.

Henry Ford, Professor Ralph Haswell Lutz,

chairman of the board of the Herbert Hoover War Library; a number of influential educators; Thomas J. Watson, then American head of the International Chamber of Commerce, and James David Mooney, vice-president of General Motors Corp., then in charge of overseas operations.

Watson returned his medal in protest against Nazi brutality. Similarly William Guggenheim returned an Italian Fascist decoration in protest against Italy's conduct.

He Worked Hard

Mooney, a chum of Gerhard Westrick, Hitler's mysterious representative sent here to corrupt opinion in Wall Street, has worked to corrupt opinion in Wall Street, has worked hard for his Nazi medal. He recently, after talking to Westrick, published and widely distributed a pamphlet, written by himself, paralleling current Nazi propaganda for the U. S. A. It magnifies, as Hitler does, the horrors of war, the ghastly things that would happen to us if we entered, urges us to keep out, and urges strongly that we be ready, at out, and urges strongly that we be ready, at the proper moment, to intervene in peace negotiations. That is what Hitler asks us, too, strangely enough.

More strangely, Mooney's Nazi propaganda parallel utterances are read into the Congressional Record, and again widely dis-

tributed, franked at the taxpayers cost.

He has now been given a key job in U. S. national defense. No firm in the U. S. A. rearmament program is more important than General Motors. Its president, William Knudsen, is in actual charge of all production.
